"Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!" - Psalms 133:1 NKJV




Our endeavours include supporting quality education through partnerships with local schools and organizations. We believe in the transformative power of education and work towards providing equal opportunities for all, regardless of background.

Paramount Chief Papa Osikol II, also known as Sir Hilary Beckles, Vice Chancellor of the University of the West Indies, shared valuable insights into the rich history of the Maroon communities in Jamaica, spanning 286 years, and their unwavering quest for freedom.

Embarking on a three-hour journey from Kingston to Accompong in Cockpit Country, the Royal delegation, upon arrival, was welcomed by Chief Richard Currie, Paramount Chief of the State of Accompong. The festival activities included a symposium, a civil ceremony around the symbolic Kindah Tree, and a commemorative march, symbolizing the Maroons' victorious struggle for freedom.

Community leaders expressed a sincere desire for unity among the Maroon leaders in attendance, leading to commitments to reconciliation and a proposed call to action.


